FEEDING GUIDE

Begin feeding **SureBreed** maturation diet one month prior to spawning, at a daily rate of 2.5–3.5% of broodstock biomass. Offer as the first meal of the day, after siphoning. Do not mix **SureBreed** with fresh feeds in the same ration.

A weaning period of 1–2 weeks is recommended. Fresh feed should be gradually substituted with **SureBreed** on a dry matter basis.

For example, 1 kg of fresh feed (20% dry matter) can be replaced with 278 g of **SureBreed** (72% dry matter). If necessary, further reduce fresh feed inclusion to stimulate appetite.

SureBreed can replace up to 70% of fresh feed during maturation, and thus significantly increase nutritional consistency and biosecurity.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Weigh out the required amount of feed and spread evenly over the water surface.

STORAGE

Store cool (< 5°C) and dry. Oxygen absorber included. Once opened, keep refrigerated and use within 1 month.
